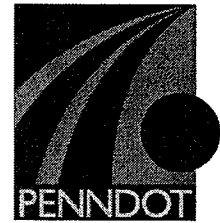

A CAC meeting was held at the Doylestown Township Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. on January 24, 2007. The following is a summary of the discussions at this meeting:

Summary

- Madeleine Fausto opened the meeting and thanked the CAC members for coming to the meeting and asked that everyone introduce themselves.
- Ken McFadden reviewed the design changes of SR 6202 for Section 721. The shared-use path (SUP) will travel along the southbound lanes of SR 6202 from Bristol Road to Lower State Road. Almshouse Road will be lowered approximately 1'-6" at the SR 6202 overpass to eliminate the substandard intersection sight distance at Almshouse Road and Quail Drive.

Right-of-Way Fence

- Fence that delineates PENNDOT Right-of-Way is not required for this project. However, PENNDOT will construct right-of-way fence at the request of residents along the corridor. This fence would be set 1'-2' off of the property line within PENNDOT right-of-way.
- Residents were strongly opposed to fencing along the corridor. Earth berms and landscaping will be provided as a visual buffer between SR 6202 and residents.

General Comments

- Current plans call for the bicycle lane striping of the 5' paved shoulder along SR 6202 to end at Lower State Road. A request was made to investigate the feasibility of providing access to the bike lanes from New Britain Road. **Subsequent to the meeting, Urban investigated the request and determined that property impacts and drainage requirements preclude the construction of bike lane access ramps at New Britain Road.**
- The SUP will be pulled next to SR 6202 at roadway, stream and wetland crossings to minimize structure widths and environmental impacts.
- Trucks will not be restricted from using SR 6202 after construction is complete.


Next Steps

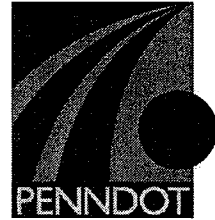
