Route 63 (Welsh Road), Stump Road to Route 202 (DeKalb Pike)

- **Periodic stoppages up to 15-minutes Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

Montgomery Township, Montgomery County

Route 463 (Horsham Road), Upper State Road to Stump Road

- Intermittent lane closures Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.

Warrington Township, Bucks County

Route 152 (Limekiln Pike), Route 202 (Butler Avenue) to Stump Road

- Intermittent lane closures Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.
