

## **LANE CLOSURES ON ROUTE 309 IN MONTGOMERY TOWNSHIP FRIDAY NIGHT**

**08/23/2010 – KING OF PRUSSIA**

Route 309 (Bethlehem Pike) will be reduced from two lanes-to-one in each direction Friday night into Saturday morning, Aug. 27-28, for bridge construction activities at the new Route 202 Parkway overpass in Montgomery Township, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation said today.

One lane northbound and one lane southbound will be closed from 9 p.m. Friday until 5 a.m. Saturday between Knapp Road and Upper State Road/Route 202 (DeKalb Pike).

The lane restrictions will allow crews to remove shielding and construction platforms from the new overpass.

Motorists are advised to allow extra time for travel through the work zone.

All planned operations are weather permitting.

The work is part of the \$200 million Route 202 Parkway, currently under construction in Doylestown and Warrington townships, Bucks County, and Montgomery and Lower Gwynedd townships, Montgomery County.

The nine mile-long Parkway, which is financed with 100 percent state funds, will have four travel lanes between Route 63 and Route 463 and two lanes between Route 463 and Route 611.
