

Almshouse Beams Release
August 3, 2010

Stoppages Friday for Beam Setting on Almshouse Road in Doylestown Township

Drivers using Almshouse Road in Doylestown Township, Bucks County, will experience periodic stoppages on Friday, Aug. 6, as crews place beams for the new Route 202 Parkway overpass that is under construction between Lower and Upper State roads.

Six full stoppages of up to 15 minutes will occur between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to allow workers to lift and set the beams.

Motorists should allow extra time for travel through the work area.

The scheduled operation is weather permitting.

The nine mile-long Route 202 Parkway is under construction in Doylestown and Warrington townships, Bucks County, and Montgomery and Lower Gwynedd townships, Montgomery County. It will have four travel lanes between Route 63 and Route 463 and two lanes between Route 463 and Route 611. The \$200 million project is financed with 100 percent state funds.

The Parkway is scheduled to be completed and open to traffic in mid-2012.
