



This is a follow up to the PennDOT news release issued last Friday (April 8) on the moving of 12 large concrete bridge beams through Doylestown Borough and Doylestown Township for the construction of the US 202 Parkway bridge over Neshaminy Creek. The schedule for transporting the beams from Cressona, Pa. to Doylestown has been revised and the updated delivery schedule is:

Tuesday, April 12: Four Beams were transported to Route 611/Route 202 Interchange; two beams were moved and delivered to the bridge construction site;

Thursday, April 14: Two beams will be transported to the Route 611/Broad Street Interchange; four beams will be moved and delivered to the bridge construction site that night after 6 p.m. and 7 p.m.; and

Monday, April 18: Four beams are scheduled to be transported to the Route 611/Broad Street Interchange; four beams will be moved and delivered to the construction site that night after 6 p.m. and 7 p.m.

The delivery date of the remaining two beams will be announced when the date is confirmed.
