## **Daytime and Nighttime Lane Closures Next Week on Bethlehem Pike in Montgomeryville**

### ***For 202 Parkway construction between Knapp Road and DeKalb Pike***

**KING OF PRUSSIA** – Motorists on Route 309 (Bethlehem Pike) in Montgomeryville will encounter daytime and nighttime lane closures next week (Oct. 25-30) at the Route 202 Parkway Interchange, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation said today.

The contractor's schedule is as follows:

- Northbound Route 309 (Bethlehem Pike) will be reduced to one lane between Knapp Road and Route 202 (DeKalb Pike) Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.
- Northbound and southbound Route 309 (Bethlehem Pike) will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Knapp Road and Route 202 (DeKalb Pike) Monday through Friday from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. the following morning.

The closures will allow crews to complete paving and other construction activities at the interchange, which is under construction as part of PennDOT's \$200 million Route 202 Parkway in Bucks and Montgomery counties.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and to add extra time for travel through the work areas.

All planned activities are weather permitting.
