BRISTOL ROAD DETOURS LIFTED

PennDOT today (Nov. 24) reopened Bristol Road to eastbound and westbound traffic between Upper State and Stump roads in Warrington Township on Wednesday (Nov. 24), the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation announced today.

The detour, which was put in place in September for eastbound Bristol Road traffic and expanded in October to include westbound traffic, was needed to allow crews to widen and reconstruct Bristol Road at its connection with the new Parkway.

The work on Bristol Road is part of the project to construct the nine-mile, \$200 million Route 202 Parkway in Bucks and Montgomery counties and the \$17.7 million project to widen and improve Route 202 between Hancock Road and Route 309 in Montgomery County.
