



## Public Hearing for SR 202, Section 700, Montgomery & Bucks Counties

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, in compliance with Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Act 120 of 1970, has prepared an Environmental Evaluation Report (EER) for SR 202, Section 700 in Montgomery and Bucks Counties, Pennsylvania. A Public Hearing will be held to provide interested persons an opportunity to testify on the effects of the project, including its social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed action as described in the EER.

The proposed Route 202 Parkway alternative is recommended to relieve traffic congestion and improve capacity and safety on Route 202 from PA 63 in Upper Gwynedd Township, Montgomery County, to the PA 611 Bypass in Doylestown Township, Bucks County in order to address the current and future transportation needs of this corridor.

**The Public Hearing will be conducted on Wednesday, February 28, 2007** at Lenape Middle School, 313 West State Street, Doylestown, PA 18901.

In the event of a snowstorm, which would cause the Central Bucks School District to close Lenape Middle School (#755) on February 28, the Route 202 Public Hearing would be postponed until Wednesday, March 7. The location and time of the Public Hearing would remain the same.

A plans display will be conducted prior to and during the Public Hearing at the same location beginning at 5:00 P.M. The Department of Transportation official testimony will begin at 5:30 P.M. followed by public testimony until all testimony is received.

Official project testimony may be given by any of the following means:

1. Oral testimony at the public hearing.
2. Written testimony presented at the hearing.
3. Written testimony sent to PennDOT during the comment period.

All comments will become part of the formal record of the hearing. Oral comments will be limited to five minutes or less. Written comments may be submitted in support of oral testimony. Any written comments should be submitted to:
